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PAINT OUT RULES

Open to painters 16 years of age and older.

- Canvases must be stamped between 7:00 and 8:30 am during registration and check-in at the Brown County Art Guild. Unstamped work will not be judged.
- Registration fee includes paint out entry, morning and afternoon refreshments. Fees are nonrefundable. The contest will be held rain or shine.
- Paintings must be created between 7:00 am and 1:00 pm on Sunday, September 13, 2020.
- All painting media is eligible. Artwork subject matter must be of Brown County and its townships.
- · Canvases may be toned ahead of time.
- · Two paintings may be entered for judging.
- Paintings are NOT to be signed by the artist until after judging.
- Participants are responsible for transporting their works to the Tuckaway Courtyard by 1:00 pm for judging, exhibition and possible sale. Artists must provide an easel. A frame is optional for being judged and exhibited.
- The sale price and name for the painting(s) is determined by the artist. Tags will be provided and must be filled out upon delivery of painting(s).
- Paintings submitted for judging must be available for sale and exhibition in the Tuckaway Courtyard from 2:30-4:00 pm during the Brown County Art Colony Weekend closing reception.
- All painting sales, sales tax, & applicable credit card fees of entered works will be handled and processed by the Brown County Art Guild during the event. Sales of paintings require a commission contribution of 30% to support the Guild, its programs and services. Private sales are permitted during the paint out for any work NOT entered in the competition.
- Unsold works are to be removed from the Tuckaway Courtyard at 4:00 pm.
- Winning works shall be framed by the artist and remain on display for sale through September 30, 2020.
